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Part 1 – General Information and Overview

1.1 Contact Information

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1.2 Description of the Initiative

The college is implementing edEHR, an open-source, cloud-hosted electronic health records tool, within the college learning management system (D2L) for use in the delivery of nursing and other health professional courses. Camosun is adopting this tool in collaboration with provincial partners Selkirk and BCIT on this initiative.

This initiative addresses the recommendation arising from the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing (CASN) accreditation report. The college is committed to preparing students for workplaces where they are required to access healthcare informatics platforms in the routine care of their clients and patients for care documentation, interprofessional collaboration, laboratory and diagnostics reports, medication management and documentation, and client privacy and safety.

Implementation of edEHR is also driven by the University of Victoria curriculum partnership to better prepare student nurses for the informatics paradigm of their practice, an entry to practice competency.

edEHR is integrated within D2L based on the LTI integration standard. Access to the EdEHR tool is through D2L, no additional third-party software or plugins are required.

1.3 Scope of PIA

This Privacy Impact Assessment covers:

- Privacy and security of the edEHR service
- Data shared between Camosun's D2L instance and edEHR
- Disclosure, retention and disposition of personal information

This PIA covers the structure and function of EdEHR.org and the data collection and management from the LMS data link to EdEHR.org servers

There are no other privacy impact assessments related to this PIA. Selkirk College, another user of this product was consulted.

The following information and data elements are collected in the use of edEHR

edEHR is an open source collaborative. EdEHR is a Canadian initiative funded by BC Campus and partner institutions; all of its services are hosted on DigitalOcean servers based in Toronto.

No information is stored outside of Canada. EDEHR.org uses servers located in Toronto with DigitalOcean. Section 15(1)(f)

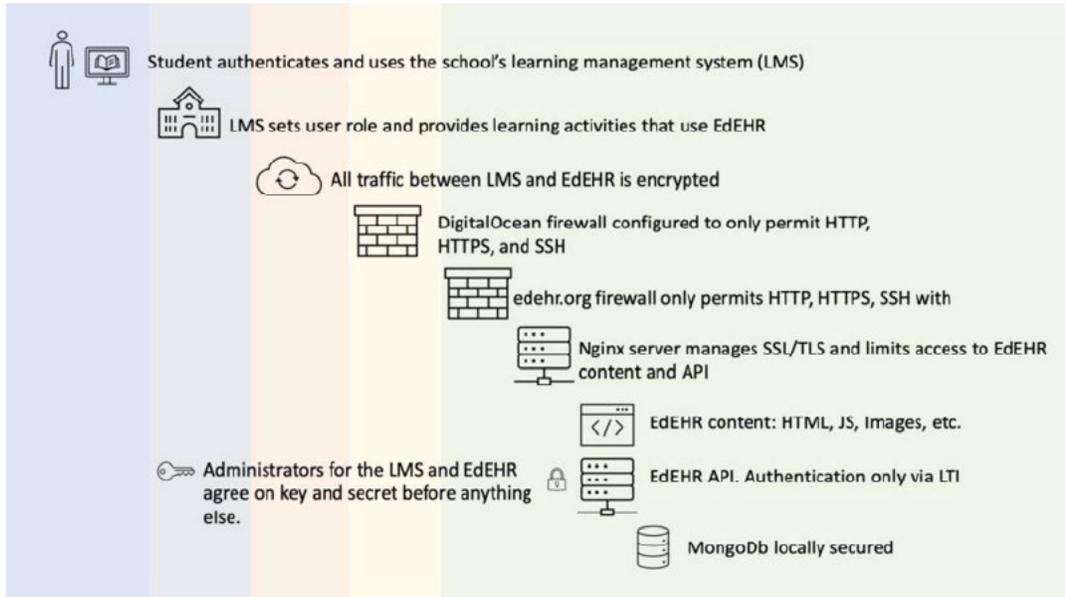

Suggested text for this notice:

As part of your learning experience at Camosun College, you will be using a third-party resource called EdEHR.org, located outside of D2L and the college's network.

The purpose of integrating this tool into your learning experience is to facilitate and improve your knowledge of electronic health records in clinical practice. The personal information collected by edEHR when you use this tool include ID number (C#), first and last name and assignment submitted. The purposes for which that information is used by the third party are to allow instructors to create simulated interactions with an electronic health record.

Use of this cloud-based tool is in compliance with college policy and BC Privacy Legislation.

This cloud-based learning tool is provided through a third party and is therefore not managed by or stored on institutional computer servers. Information that you provide when using this tool and applications will be stored on computer servers located inside Canada. In particular, your information will be stored on servers in Toronto. 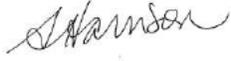
5.4 Implementation
