1. What is the initiative?

Gravyty is a higher education software company that provides tools directed towards alumni engagement, donor stewardship, and university development. Within their product suite, there are two web-based software tools utilized by the Emily Carr University (ECU) Alumni Relations (AR) and University Advancement (UA) offices: Graduway and Gratavid.

Graduway is utilized by AR and is a white label social and professional networking platform intended for use by alumni, students, staff, faculty, and employers (public facing platform name is "The Leeway"). The purpose of Graduway is facilitation of peer-to-peer and mentor-mentee relationships, job postings, resources, and general networking. It is operated in collaboration between AR and Career Development + Work Integrated Learning (CDWIL). Information Technology (IT) department provides IT oversight and holds administrative access permissions to the platform.

Users can sign up for a Graduway account via email or Single Sign-On (SSO) through preexisting social networking sites such as Facebook (FB) and LinkedIn (LI) or SSO via Google and Apple. Platform signup is entirely voluntary for all users. Upon sign up for an account, users can network with their peers, seek employment or collaboration opportunities, find individuals with similar interests by joining groups, seek or offer mentorship, share their accomplishments, invite ECU community members to their events, and hire people from the ECU community.

Graduway connects to ECU's Raiser's Edge NXT (RENXT) platform, which houses our alumni and donor database and Gratavid for video automation through platform triggers such as creating a profile or joining a group. There is an admin email accessible only by the departmental administrators of the platform. This platform has been in place at ECU since 2020 and is intended to form part of ECU's IT infrastructure in perpetuity at the drafting of this PIA on March 20, 2024.



Gratavid is a donor stewardship and alumni engagement video messaging tool. The purpose of Gratavid is to leverage personalized video content to help reach ECU’s community building and philanthropic goals in advance of the 100th Anniversary. Gratavid is utilized by both AR and UA. AR utilizes Gratavid among the alumni community to welcome them to Graduway, celebrate their milestones, and for event outreach. UA utilizes Gratavid for relationship building with donors, stewardship, and event outreach. Gratavid connects to RENXT and Graduway for both automation and data storage. There is an admin email accessible only by the departmental administrators of the platform. Gratavid is in use for a two-year contract from March 2024 to March 2026 to encompass the 100th Anniversary goals and events with the possibility of being retained beyond the initial contract.

2. What is the scope of this PIA?

In scope:

- The collection, use, disclosure, storage and access of personal information via ECU’s use of two platform offered by Gravyty’s product suite: Gratavid and Graduway
- Controls established by ECU to manage the flows of personal information between the two platforms and other ECU systems/platforms
- Use of the platform by any ECU students, staff, faculty, external employers (limited access)

Out of scope:

- Comprehensive assessment of the privacy and security controls of ECU platforms integrated with Gravyty product suite (e.g., RENXT) as those require separate PIAs
- Assessment of the privacy and security controls of third-party platforms utilized for SSO or other information exchange functionalities
- Human Resources-related policies, practices and controls for collection, use, disclosure, and storage of student personal information for the purposes of student employment
- Alumni Relations-related policies, practices and controls for the collection, use, disclosure and storage of donor personal information for the purposes of processing donations to ECU
- Historical use of Gravyty’s product suite as covered in previously approved PIAs

3. What are the data or information elements involved in the initiative?

Graduway collects, stores, uses, and transfers data from alumni, students, staff, faculty, and employers from internal and external sources, depending on the activity requested (e.g., SSO from Facebook, sign-on validation information collected from Facebook; alumni status pulled from RENXT). Further information is provided in the sections below.

Gratavid uses data collected by RENXT and Graduway to distribute videos to constituents and records opens, views, sends, and unsubscribes back into RENXT and Graduway.

¹ Additional Educational Information refers to other educational institutions an affiliation may have attended. They can include the name of the institution, their degree type, major, minor, and location.

² Professional Information includes items generally described on a resume, such as industry worked in, company worked for, duration of experience or employment.

³ Social Media Profile Data is collected if a user chooses to use Facebook or LinkedIn to sign in to the platform as prepopulated profile data. Users can choose to edit or alter the information. For those that choose LinkedIn, it also allows for the import of the Professional Information and creates a profile badge linking to their external LinkedIn profile.

⁴ Location data is not IP address collection but typed in by the user, ie: Vancouver, Vancouver Island, Lower Mainland, etc.



**Alumni student numbers are added manually to facilitate a sync between Graduway and RENXT but it is not mandatory for them to disclose this upon signup. Students will be required to include their student number upon sign up. Both affiliations are welcome to use an alias or artist name during sign up. Student numbers are not visible to anyone but admins.*

***Only collected if a student or alumni elects to apply for a job via Graduway. Application information would be a cover letter, resume, CV, and/or portfolio based on what the posting requests and is up to the discretion of the applicant.*

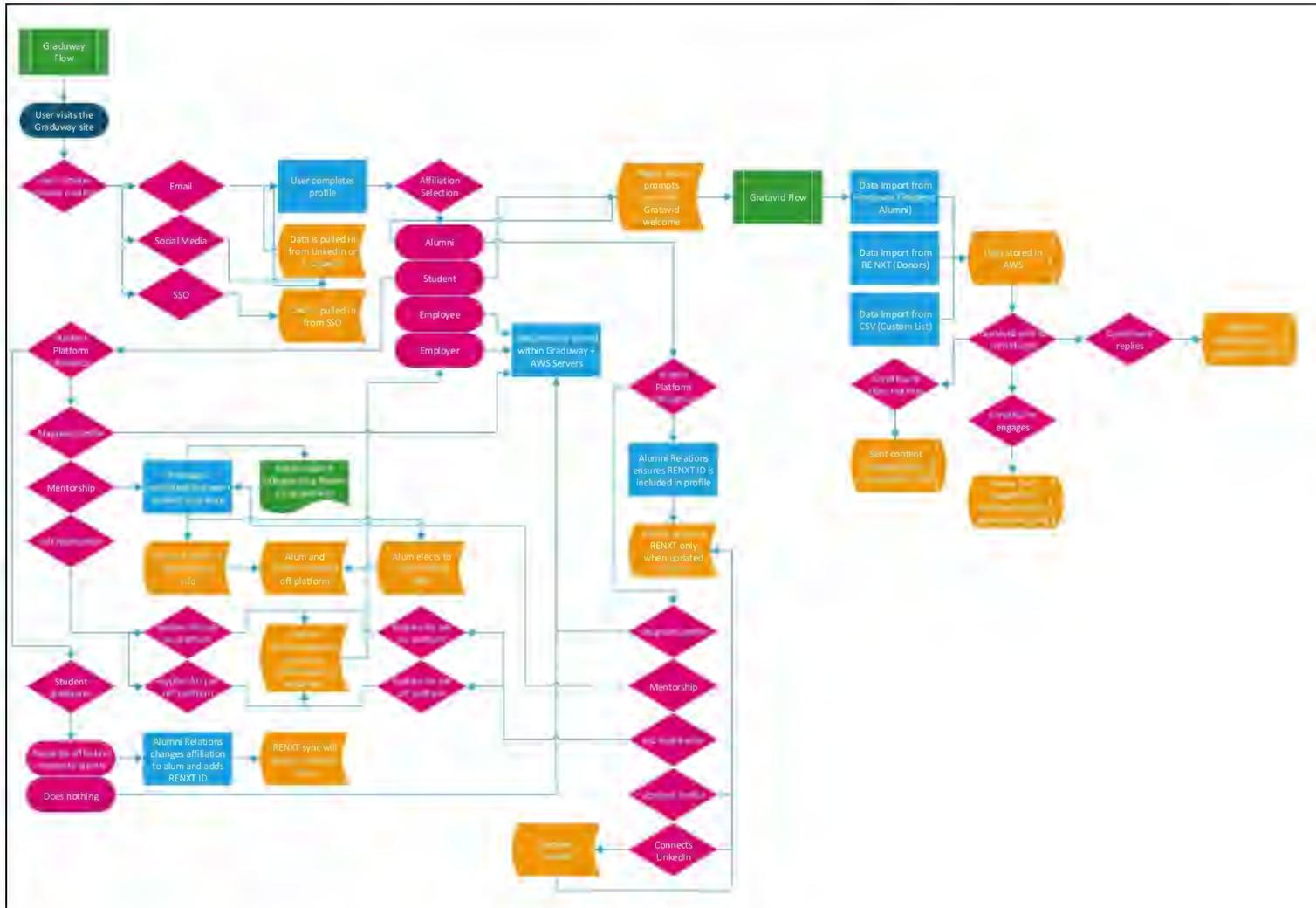

5. Collection Notice

Graduway ("The Leeway") is a networking platform available to the Emily Carr University (ECU) community of alumni, faculty, staff and students for the purposes of connecting with other users, networking, and supporting university programs and activities, including but not limited to fundraising, fostering alumni engagement, updating Advancement mailing lists, and updating donor databases. The personal information you provide upon signing up and creating a profile (e.g., your name, contact information, education and employment history) is collected by ECU under section 26(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. By using The Leeway, you recognize you are signed up to receive information about university developments, invitations to events and fundraising activities via email. You understand that ECU will keep your personal information secure and that you can access information held about you or ask ECU to stop contacting you and storing your data at any time.

The Leeway is a voluntary service provided by ECU, and it is your decision whether you choose to participate in it. ECU uses a third-party provider, Gravyty, to make Graduway's services available to you. Prior to signing up for an account, please review the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy to confirm your agreement with how Gravyty will use and disclose the information you provide when engaging with The Leeway. Where you decide to use a third-party to sign-on to your user account (e.g., Facebook SSO), the verification process including collection and use of your personal information by the third party is governed under their Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. By linking your Leeway account to a third-party account, you acknowledge that you are accepting the risks associated with this type of verification process.

Where you decide to create a new user account via the Leeway (and do not connect to a SSO provider), **please note that the Leeway's password strength requirements do not meet ECU's password standard.** We strongly recommend creating a password that complies with ECU's requirements: at least (13) characters, including at least (1) uppercase letter, (1) lowercase letter, (1) number and (1) non-alphanumeric character.

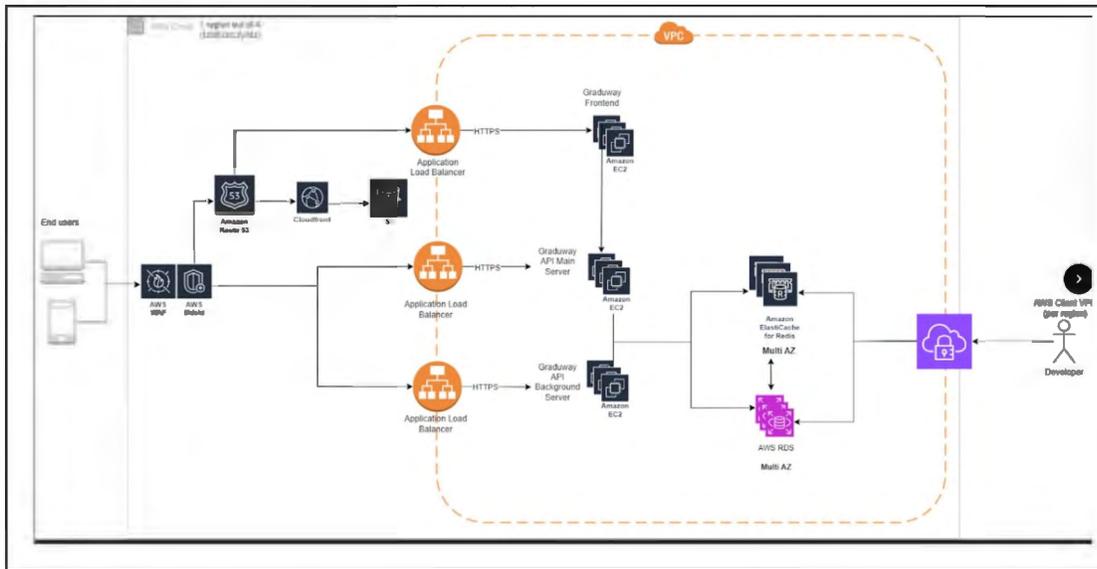

Both Gravid and Graduway instances are hosted in AWS- Canada Central cloud infrastructure located in Montreal. This infrastructure hosts all ECU data, including back-ups, log files and transitory files. All information is encrypted in transit (TLS 1.3) and at rest (AES 256).

Graduway is a single tenant database and Gravid is a multi-tenant database with a logical separation of customers (based on geographical location). Network infrastructure diagram from Graduway provided below.

Yes, it involves sensitive information; however as noted above, all information is stored either in Gravyty’s AWS servers located in Canada or ECU’s locally managed RENXT database (donors).

User Accounts

Graduway - Employer Accounts

For employers, once they select “employer” status when they are creating their profile, the account is locked out of all areas of the platform other than the job board. Employers do not have access to personal information of students applying for jobs posted by the employer via Graduway, and as such, students must ensure they have the appropriate info available in their submitted documents for the employer to contact them. ECU does not release any student personal information to the employer on the student’s behalf.

Gratavid – Student Creator Accounts

Where hired by ECU to support the creation of donor videos via Gratavid, students are not provided with an account to access Gratavid. Rather, select ECU AR employees will be assigned account permissions for Gratavid, and then they can create video requests where access permissions are assigned to a specific user / email link. This can be for (1) one video from one person (2) multiple videos from one person (3) one video per one person for multiple people. Students are then sent a link to access Gratavid with their access limited to the video request assigned to them.

Data Retention and Destruction

Graduway – User Accounts and Chats

Users can deactivate and delete their account at any time. All user data is destroyed upon deletion of the user account including any transitory messages such as chats. No user account information is retained by Graduway; it can take 1-4 months for full overwrite to be completed. Graduway does not retain any backups, log files or transitory documents.

Gratavid – Videos

Videos are retained per the length of the contract and can be deleted by the admin/user who has access to the Gratavid dashboard. Videos can be downloaded if that ability has been toggled on by ECU admins (at the time of writing, ECU planned to have downloads toggled on). Once deleted Gratavid does not have access to the videos. It can take 1-4 months for complete overwrite to be completed. Gratavid does not retain any backups, log files or transitory documents.

For users outside ECU (e.g., donors who receive a video), they will need to request deletion via ECU as direct deletion is not available to the recipient.

Contract Expiry

Upon expiry of the contracts for both platforms, ECU sites will be disabled by Gravyty. Initial closure of sites is estimated to take 2-3 weeks, and full overwrite can take 1-4 months. As noted above, no backups, log files or transitory documents are retained.



Logging and Auditing

General Overview

Gravyty utilizes AWS CloudWatch via DataDog for its platforms, which is configured to track all access, change and activity logs, including login, logout, actions performed, and source IP address, and this log can be provided on an ad-hoc basis. Additional details about Gravyty's proactive and reactive monitoring and detection activities are outlined in the respective HEVCATs and via trust.gravyty.com/security and aws.amazon.com/compliance/data-center/data-centers.

ECU Users - Graduway

ECU admin accounts have permission to access audit logs in the Graduway administrator dashboard. The audit logs capture details outlined above (login, logout, actions performed, and source IP address). No proactive monitoring and auditing processes has been developed to date for general activities recorded on the Graduway platform.

ECU admin accounts are also provided access to the Safeguarding Report in the administrator dashboard, which provides a log of all chat interactions between users on the platform. AR has developed a process to audit interactions between users to ensure interactions adhere to the platform's Code of Conduct. The AR super admin account is appointed oversight of the report and auditing activities (including escalation processes).

ECU Users - Gratavid

ECU admin accounts have permission to access audit logs in the Gratavid administrator dashboard. The audit logs capture details outlined above (login, logout, actions performed, and source IP address). No proactive monitoring and auditing processes has been developed to date for general activities recorded on the Gratavid platform.

Gravyty Staff

Gravyty support and onboarding teams have access to ECU sites for training and support purposes. In addition to the logging activities noted above changes to the ECU database are also logged and audited; however, for Gratavid, the auditing mechanism is pending implementation as ECU is currently in the process of setting up its Gratavid platform.

In terms of the Safeguarding Report, only specific Gravyty employees (support and onboarding teams) have access to the platform and can, if needed, download the Safeguarding Report for troubleshooting/testing purposes, although this is rare. The report cannot be edited or deleted.

Breach Reporting

Gravyty has a [breach reporting process in place](#) that meets requirements of the GDPR; however, no FIPPA privacy protection schedule was included with the contracts for either Graduway or Gratavid. Gravyty has demonstrated willingness to consider amendment of the contracts to include the FIPPA privacy protection schedule.

Part 6 – Accuracy, Correction + Retention

18. Do you have a process in place to correct personal information?

Users can update their profile information and any information they wish to share in Graduway at any time via their account settings.

The only information collected by ECU AR and UA via Graduway to update other databases is the alumni data in RENXT, which is collected from alumni who choose to create an account and complete their profile. The information is limited to first name, last name, email, employment data.

No information correction process required for Gratavid given no personal information is being generated by Gratavid. The information being used to create videos are governed by AR policies and processes that are subject to ECU’s standard privacy and information access requirements.

At any point, current students, alumni and staff can request access to and correction of any personal information held by ECU via ECU’s standard information request process.

19. Does your initiative use personal information to make decisions that directly affect an individual(s)?

No – not directly using information collected from Gratavid or Graduway. However, employers will make decisions about a person with consideration to their employment application. This may include ECU HR making decisions where the employment opportunity is an internal position (either via a job posting on the Leeway or student employment for Gratavid video creation).

Where ECU is the employer, the applicant’s personal information will be retained by HR for minimum of one year as per FIPPA requirements and ECU’s privacy, HR, and information access policies.

20. Do you have a retention schedule in place related to personal information used to make decisions? Retention and/or disposition schedule that will ensure that personal information is kept for at least one year after it is used in making a decision directly affecting an individual?

Yes – ECU has a retention schedule and process in place for HR applications and related employment decisions.

Currently Gravyty requires passwords to include: 8 characters, including upper/lowercase and numbers.	Advise users that the password requirements to not align with ECU's standard in the Privacy Notice. Risk 4: Gravyty in the process of setting up specific monitoring and auditing capabilities for ECU at the time of writing, limiting controls for the protection of personal information hosted on the platform.
